- Bullying will not be tolerated in any form. Every member has a responsibility to report bullying to either coaches or any official at the club, so that action can be taken to deal with the situation.

For Parents and Carers

Parents/carers are a vital part of any club. Without your support our club would not function. To ensure that our junior members get the best from our club and their training, specific conduct is required.

- Helping your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Encouraging your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discouraging unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Never forcing your child to take part in sport.
- Never punishing or belittling a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accepting official's judgements.
- Supporting your child's involvement and helping them to enjoy their sport.
- Encouraging and guiding performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
