RULES

Basic Race Skills Training at the Ackers Trust Ski Centre

Midland Ski Club has arranged race training sessions at the Ackers Trust Ski Centre to allow skiers to practise for the race. The first training session will be held on the 6th March 2011 (10.15-11.45, 12.15-13.45 & 14.15-15.45) at a cost of £10 per session per skier. Other School Group training slots are on Thursdays the 10th, 17th and 24th March from 18.00 to 19.30. To book a session place, please phone the Ackers on 0121 772 5111.

Helmet Regulations

Ski Helmets must be worn by all competitors. Helmets will not be available for hire from the Ackers. You may be able to borrow one from a friend. Alternatively, ski helmets can be purchased from a number of suppliers - a few are listed below:

Equipment and clothing

Skis, boots and poles are available for hire from the Ackers Trust and the cost is included in the race entry fee. Skiers may use their own skis and/or boots and ski poles, however ski poles must have full protection around the point to prevent damage to the slope. The use of ski blades is not permitted.

Long sleeves, gloves and long trousers must be worn at all times, and there must be no gap in clothing between shirt and trousers.

Photography

It is expected that photographs may be taken of skiers at the event and these may be included on the Midland Ski Club or the Ackers Trust websites (no names). **If any skier may not be photographed please include this information on the entry form.**

Code of Conduct

The school Team Manager will be responsible for the general conduct of the team members and ensure that good sporting behaviour is maintained at all times.

Teams must consist of 3 or 4 skiers from the same school or college, as at 14th March 2011. Teams may include skiers of either sex. Age categories are Under 8, Under 10, Under 12, Under 14, Under 16, Under 19, age as at 31st December 2010. There is a special needs category with no age group restrictions. **Entries from individuals will not be accepted.**

Skiers from different age groups may form a team and the age group of the team will be determined by the age of the oldest skier.

Each skier will make 2 timed runs of the slalom course and the best time from a skier's two runs will be used for the team event. The team time will be the total of the fastest run times for any 3 skiers in the team, (maximum of 1 time for any skier) and the winner of each age group will be the team with the lowest final combined time.

The sum of the skier's two times will be used for ranking in the individuals' event, using the skier's correct age category.

Team awards will be presented to the first 3 teams in each age group or category. Individual awards will be presented to the first 3 girls and first 3 boys in each age group or category.

The minimum standard of skiing required is to be able to perform linked snowplough turns safely, to be able to control speed and use the button lift. No previous racing experience is necessary.

A maximum of 150 skiers will be accepted and entries will be accepted only when they reach the race secretary with correct payment before the closing date (this date may be brought forward if the race is oversubscribed before the official closing date). **Payments will not be accepted from individual members of a team; a single cheque must be paid to cover one or more teams.** Entries will be accepted in the order that the form and complete payment is received; there is no guarantee that all entries received before closing date can be accepted. Schools may enter up to two teams in each age group.

Late entries or entries on the day will not be accepted. All accepted entries will be confirmed by email so please include a clearly printed email address on the entry form. No refunds will be made if skiers are unable to ski after this acceptance has been sent.

Each school must nominate a team manager, with name and contact details shown on the entry form. This team manager will be responsible for their teams during the race.
