Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Roger Crombleholme Head Coach.

As a member of Midland Ski Club you are expected to abide by the following junior code of conduct:

- 1 All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions
- 2 All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion
- 3 Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or assistant coach if they are going to be late
- 4 Members must wear suitable kit i.e. long sleeved tops, long trousers, gloves and helmet for training as agreed with the coach
- 5 Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly
- 6 Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on training premises or whilst representing the club
- 7 Junior members are not allowed to smoke on training premises or whilst representing the club at competitions
