



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/SPECTATORS

All Parent/Spectators should:

1. Be positive and encouraging towards all of the skiers in the club not just their own child/children
2. Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all
3. Avoid coaching the skier during competitions
4. Respect the organising clubs/officials decisions, discouraging unfair play and arguing with officials
5. Give attention to each of the skiers involved in the club not just the most talented
6. Give encouragement to all of the skiers participating in a competition
7. Adhere to the Club's Code of Conduct and Child Protection Policy
8. Never force you child to take part in sport
9. Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results
10. Encourage and guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour
11. Use correct and proper language at all times

It is important for Parents/Spectators to note that positive encouragement will contribute towards:

- 12(a). The Skiers enjoying skiing
- 12(b) A sense of personal achievement for the skier
- 12(c) Self esteem for the skier
- 12(d) Improving the skiers skills and techniques

- 13(a) Other skiers
- 13(b) Officials
- 13(c) Coaches/Team Managers
- 13(d) Spectators
