



**CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SKIERS PARTICIPATING IN TRAINING OR
COMPETITIVE EVENTS**

Obligations towards the Club Events

Skiers should:

1. make every effort to develop his/her own sporting abilities, in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina
2. Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during training and in a ski competition, even if you are in a position where the desired result has already been achieved
3. Set a positive example to others
4. Avoid being late for the start of your training session or race
5. Always have regard to the best interests of the ski club and any competition you enter
6. Not use inappropriate language

Obligations towards our team

A skier should:

7. Make every effort consistent with Fair Play and the Laws of Snowsport England etc.
8. Resist any influence which might, or might be seen to, bring into question his/her commitment towards other skiers either in training or at a competition

Respect for the Laws and Rules of the Ski Club and Competitions:

A skier should:

9. Know and abide by the laws, rules and spirit of the club and competitions entered into
10. Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally
11. Resist any temptation to take banned substances or use banned techniques

Respect towards Skiers:

12. Treat all skiers with due respect at all times
13. Safeguard the physical fitness of Skiers, avoid violence and help injured Skies

Respect toward Club and Competition Officials

A Skier should:

14. Avoid words or actions which may mislead an Official
15. Show respect to Officials

Respect towards Team Officials

A skier should:

16. Abide by the instructions of his/her Coach, Assistant Coach and Team Officials, provided they do not contradict the spirit of this code
17. Show respect towards the Team Officials of other Skiers

Obligations towards Supporters

A Skier should:

18. Show respect to the interests of supporters
